About Medialab

The Medialab provides students with a space to work, experiment with audiovisual tools and digital media, and expand their knowledge. It's open to all Sandberg students for both study and creative work. The space can also be used for screenings and workshops.

Medialab staff support activities and manage audiovisual equipment rentals. We also assist with the technical production of exhibited works and other student presentations, such as the Open Day in February and the Graduation Show in June.

Facilities

MediaLab (5th floor BC Building)

Several Mac and Windows workstations are available for use, equipped with Adobe Creative Suite, Microsoft Office, 3D modeling tools, video compositing software, audio editing programs, and more. Additional software can be installed upon request.

The high-performance Windows machines are specifically intended for large or demanding projects such as 3D rendering and video editing.

For prototyping installations and interactive projects, we provide soldering stations, Arduinos, Raspberry Pi's, and a small selection of related hardware such as sensors and motors.

Log in

You can log in on our MediaLab workstations with a shared local account (for speed) or with your Sandberg user account.

Video editing suite (room 530, 5th floor BC Building)

A dedicated audio-video editing room for more concentrated or complex work. This room can be booked here: reservations.rietveldacademie.nl

Sound studio (room 525, 5th floor BC Building)

We share a dedicated sound studio with the Rietveld Academie.

After the introduction you can work independently in the studio.

Location: The Basement Room K21 (BC Building)

Rentals are in principle for free and accessible to all Sandberg students, provided that membership and conditions are met. A contract will be made for each time you rent.

To rent equipment, you need liability insurance (in Dutch: WA- of aansprakelijkheids-verzekering). You can arrange this online via your bank or insurance company. Once you provide us with a copy of your insurance policy, we will create an account for you so you can reserve equipment through the online system.

Renting for others (without account or insurance polis) is not allowed.

Borrowing is free during your studies. However, for the final exam exhibition a modest fee is required as compensation for equipment use.

Pick up and Return

Please return the equipment early, preferably between 9:00 and 10:00, so others can use it the same day.

In case of illness or an emergency you may ask someone else to pick up or deliver your equipment.

If you're unable to return the equipment at the agreed time, please let us know as soon as possible, so we can inform those who have reserved the same materials.
